COLUMN 2

43 to 44- GROUND OUT (P to 1B) (was 1B to P)

GROUND OUT (1B unassisted) (was P unassisted)

61 to 65- DRIVE TOWARD THE OUTFIELD GAP

Chance for triple with less than two outs (formerly with one out only)

COLUMN 3

25 to 29- SINGLE UP THE MIDDLE

Runners advance two bases. Batter caught stealing on next pitch. (No caught stealing if trailing after 6th inning) (Now automatic CS)

43 to 47- LINE DRIVE TOWARD LEFT FIELD

vs. LEFT HANDED PITCHER:

SINGLE to left, runners advance two bases. 1 or 2 speed on first stops at second base.

48 to 52- LINE DRIVE TOWARD RIGHT FIELD

vs. LEFT HANDED PITCHER:

Leaping catch by 2B for the out, runners hold. With a runner on second and less than two outs, possible double play. • Roll one die against 2B defense. If die is higher, runner on second base is doubled off.

(Lineout DP is no longer automatic on these plays)

vs. RIGHT HANDED PITCHER:

Leaping catch by SS for the out, runners hold. With a runner on second and less than two outs, possible double play. ● Roll one die against SS defense. If die is higher, runner on second base is doubled off.

vs. RIGHT HANDED PITCHER:

SINGLE to right, runners advance two bases. 1 or 2 speed on first stops at second base.

COLUMN 4

40 to 44- LINE OUT, POSSIBLE DOUBLE PLAY

Infielder IN: SINGLE over infielder, runners advance two bases. (New for when Infielder is IN)

COLUMN 5

16 to 20- INFIELD SINGLE

Runners advance one base on the hit.

●Check Column M of the Action Chart for further on base action.

21 to 27- BASE ON BALLS

Batter takes first base, any runners advance if forced.

● Check Column M of the Action Chart for further on base action.

(Simplified these plays- now a check on new Column M of Action Chart may result in a WP, PB, PO or BK)

46 to 50- FLY OUT TO CF...

or...Action on the base paths

With bases empty, score as a **FLY OUT TO CF**.

With men on base, ocheck Column M of the Action Chart for play result.

(This new Column 5 result allows for WP, PB PO or BK to occur in any base situation)

COLUMN 6

11*- SINGLE TO RF

12*- HOME RUN DOWN THE LINE

(This new Column 6 option allows for greater variety and less certainty of outcomes at the point between a base hit and a home run in Column 6. Can be used with or without ballpark effects.)

*HOME RUN? Use for Column 6 plays 11 and 12

 Roll one die to see if batter drives the pitch for a HOME RUN.
