How to use these ratings:

Consider each of the above numbers to be a raised number placed next to the Offensive Rebound rating of each player listed.

Whenever such a player grabs an offensive rebound and the rebound does NOT have any follow-up action (such as a Column 2 shot, possible block, or steal) **roll one die...** if it's HIGHER than the small raised number, then the rebounder has been fouled in the act of shooting by his regular defender (he shoots two free throws). If the die roll is NOT HIGHER than the small raised number, then simply flip to the next Play Card as usual following the offensive rebound.
