Rules: Roll one die. Look up play result in col 6 on player card and compare to the pitcher's grade. If the play result is not a homerun, then the result is an out. The player bats until he reaches 10 outs. For the first two at bats, the pitcher's grade is 1, for at bats 3 and 4 his grade is 2, etc. After the 10th and 20th at bat, the pitcher's grade cycles back to 1.
